Paternity Testing

John 8:31-48 ³¹So He said to the Jews who had believed Him, "If you continue in My word, you are truly My disciples. ³²Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." 33"We are Abraham's descendants," they answered. "We have never been slaves to anyone. How can You say we will be set free?" ³⁴Jesus replied, "Truly, truly, I tell you, everyone who sins is a slave to sin. 35A slave is not a permanent member of the family, but a son belongs to it forever. ³⁶So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed. ³⁷I know you are Abraham's descendants, but you are trying to kill Me because My word has no place within you. ³⁸I speak of what I have seen in the presence of the Father, and you do what you have heard from your father." ³⁹"Abraham is our father," they replied. "If you were children of Abraham," said Jesus, "you would do the works of Abraham. ⁴⁰But now you are trying to kill Me, a man who has told you the truth that I heard from God. Abraham never did such a thing. ⁴¹You are doing the works of your father." "We are not illegitimate children," they declared. "Our only Father is God Himself." ⁴²Jesus said to them, "If God were your Father, you would love Me, for I have come here from God. I have not come on My own, but He sent Me. ⁴³Why do you not understand what I am saying? It is because you are unable to accept My message. ⁴⁴You belong to your father, the devil, and you want to carry out his desires. He was a murderer from the beginning, refusing to uphold the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks his native language, because he is a liar and the father of lies. 45But because I speak the truth, you do not believe Me! ⁴⁶Which of you can prove Me guilty of sin? If I speak the truth, why do you not believe Me? ⁴⁷Whoever belongs to God hears the words of God. The reason you do not hear is that you do not belong to God." ⁴⁸The Jews answered Him, "Are we not right to say that You are a Samaritan and You have a demon?" (BSB)

- **I.** Here are the details of this passage.
 - **A.** The main bulk of those who are dialoging with Jesus were men who $\underline{\textit{used}}$ to follow Him. V.31
 - **B.** Jesus made it clear that real faith stands the *test of time*. V.31
 - **C.** Jesus then used the metaphor of <u>slavery</u> to describe mankind's relationship to our sinful nature. V.32-36 Even good people are slaves to sin!
 - **D.** Only Jesus can make us <u>sons</u> of God. V.36-37
 - E. The *father* of men and women is the devil. V.38-41 44-45
 - **F.** <u>Hearing</u> the words of Jesus Christ and putting them into <u>practice</u> is the only true way to identify the children of God. V.42-43 47
 - **G.** Those who used to follow Jesus Christ couldn't defeat what He was saying so they went to *personal* attacks. V.48
- II. What does this passage teach us?
 - **A.** Just professing Jesus is not enough. He is either our <u>Lord</u> or our enemy.
 - **B.** The Gospel is not just for <u>bad</u> people.
 - C. Our worldview has got to be the same as how Jesus taught us to believe.
 - **D.** The only way to defeat the devil is to <u>follow</u> Jesus. There is a difference between <u>power</u> encounters and <u>truth</u> encounters in spiritual warfare.
 - E. Expect the world to attack us *personally*. Real persecution is coming!
