Immanuel

Matthew 1:18-25 ¹⁸This is how the birth of Jesus Christ came about: His mother Mary was pledged in marriage to Joseph, but before they came together, she was found to be with Child through the Holy Spirit. ¹⁹Because Joseph her husband was a righteous man and was unwilling to disgrace her publicly, he resolved to divorce her quietly. ²⁰But after he had pondered these things, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to embrace Mary as your wife, for the One conceived in her is from the Holy Spirit. ²¹She will give birth to a Son, and you are to give Him the name Jesus, because He will save His people from their sins." ²²All this took place to fulfill what the Lord had said through the prophet: ²³"Behold, the virgin will be with child and will give birth to a son, and they will call Him Immanuel" (which means, "God with us"). ²⁴When Joseph woke up, he did as the angel of the Lord had commanded him, and embraced Mary as his wife. ²⁵But he had no union with her until she gave birth to a Son. And he gave Him the name Jesus. (BSB)

- **I.** Here are the details of this passage in the light of it being the fulfillment of the prophecy of the birth of Immanuel.
 - **A.** *Marriage* was different then than it is now.
 - **B.** Mary became *supernaturally* pregnant. V. 18
 - **C.** Joseph did not want to have Mary <u>stoned</u> so he planned on ending the marriage quietly. V. 19
 - **D.** An Angel appeared to Joseph in a <u>dream</u> and counselled him that this was of God. V.20
 - E. The angel told Joseph to name Him Jesus. V.21
 - **F.** This unplanned pregnancy was a complete *fulfillment* of a prophecy from Isaiah 7.
 - G. Joseph did what he was instructed to do and stayed married to Mary. V.24-25
- **II.** Why is all of this so important?
 - **A.** We know from the way that Jesus was treated by the religious leaders that something <u>unusual</u> happened involving His birth.

John 8: 41, 48

- ⁴¹You are doing the works of your [own] father." They said to Him, "We are not illegitimate children; we have one [spiritual] Father: God." (Amplified)
- ⁴⁸The Jews answered Him, "Are we not right when we say You are a Samaritan and [that You] have a demon [and are under its power]?" (Amplified)
- **B.** We all have to decide who Jesus is to us. There is only a *narrow* road for the truth.
- **C.** We must be willing to face *persecution* for lifting up Jesus Christ.
- **D.** We must be willing to *reevaluate* our priorities to what God's priorities are.
