Proverbs 11:1-10 ¹Dishonest scales are an abomination to the LORD, but an accurate weight is His delight. ²When pride comes, disgrace follows, but with humility comes wisdom. ³The integrity of the upright guides them, but the perversity of the faithless destroys them. ⁴Riches are worthless in the day of wrath, but righteousness brings deliverance from death. ⁵The righteousness of the blameless directs their path, but the wicked fall by their own wickedness. ⁶The righteousness of the upright delivers them, but the faithless are trapped by their own desires. ⁷When the wicked man dies, his hope perishes, and the hope of his strength vanishes. ⁸The righteous man is delivered from trouble; in his place the wicked man goes in. ⁹With his mouth the ungodly man destroys his neighbor, but through knowledge the righteous are rescued. ¹⁰When the righteous thrive, the city rejoices, and when the wicked perish, there are shouts of joy. (BSB)

 - F. There is more to our *existence* than just our years on earth. V.7-8
 - G. Our words matter! V.9
 - H. Our existence on this earth has *eternal* consequences! V.10
- II. What can we learn from this?
 - A. It is important that God's people get <u>involved</u> in solving societal problems.
 We cannot sit out when people are being taken advantage of.
 - B. The *attitude* that Christ had must become our *attitude*. Philippians 2
 - C. It is important that we love *people* and use *money*.
 - **D.** Focus on the <u>*little*</u> aspects of following Christ and the big issues tend to sort themselves out.
 - E. We must be guided by the *big picture* of what God is doing in our generation.
 - F. Reminder: keep your words to a *minimum*.
 - G. <u>Honor</u> the righteous in our life.
