Proverbs Series: Heart Health #1

Proverbs 14:

- ¹⁰ The heart knows its own bitterness, and no stranger shares in its joy. (BSB)
- ¹³ Even in laughter the heart may ache, and joy may end in sorrow. (BSB)
- ¹⁴ The backslider in heart receives the fill of his own ways, but a good man is rewarded for his ways. (BSB)
- ³⁰ A tranquil heart is life to the body, but envy rots the bones. (BSB)
- ³³ Wisdom rests in the heart of the discerning; even among fools she is known. (BSB)
- Intro: The Hebrew word for "heart" that is used here, "Leb" (Labe,) means the center of a person. The seat of a person's mind, emotions and will.
- 1. Verse 10: All humans have *secret* bitterness and *secret* joys in their heart.
- 2. Verse 13: Our outward *appearance* is no indication of what is going on in our heart.
- 3. Verse 14: Our behavior has *consequences* to our heart, both good and bad.
- 4. Verse 30: A *contented* heart brings peace and health to our bodies.
- 5. Verse 33: We must desire God's wisdom to *dominate* our mind, our emotions and will. Even the foolish desire such things.
- **Conclusion:** Let's spend some time in prayer praying through these verses, asking God to give us healthy hearts.
