- **3** A crucible for silver and a furnace for gold, but the LORD is the tester of hearts.
- 6 Grandchildren are the crown of the aged, and the glory of a son is his father.
- **16** Why should the fool have money in his hand with no intention of buying wisdom?
- **20** The one with a perverse heart finds no good, and he whose tongue is deceitful falls into trouble.
- **22** A joyful heart is good medicine, but a broken spirit dries up the bones. (BSB)
- God desires to use all of our <u>struggles</u> to purify our hearts so that we will be more like Him. V. 3
- 2. We must be valuers of life. <u>Children</u> are not a burden but a blessing. V. 6
- **3.** Wisdom is to be <u>valued</u> above any monetary gain. V. 16 The word "heart" is used here. The interpreter interpreted it as intention.
- We must be people who look for the <u>good</u> in others. Our tongue must be used to build others up truthfully. V. 20
- 5. A heart that is filled with *joy* positively affects the health of the body. V. 22
- Let's spend some time in prayer, praying for God to use each verse to give us the heart that He desires.
