The Proverbs Series: Where Our Heart Is Safe

Proverbs 18:10-15 ¹⁰The name of the LORD is a strong tower; the righteous run to it and are safe. ¹¹A rich man's wealth is his fortified city; it is like a high wall in his imagination. ¹²Before his downfall a man's heart is proud, but humility comes before honor. ¹³He who answers a matter before he hears it— this is folly and disgrace to him. ¹⁴The spirit of a man can endure his sickness, but who can survive a broken spirit? ¹⁵The heart of the discerning acquires knowledge, and the ear of the wise seeks it out. (BSB)

Here are the details of each verse in our text for today.

- God's name is a powerful place of <u>protection</u>. He is the uncreated one who is bound by His word and His character. V. 10
- Wealth cannot protect us from bad things happening. Wealth gives a <u>false</u> sense of safety. V. 11
- **3.** We must deal with our <u>pride</u> if we are going to be the people of God that He wants us to be. Humility is a key component of a heart that is in alignment with God's heart. V. 12
- **4.** We must train ourselves to be good <u>*listeners*</u>. We must resist coming to conclusions before we have heard all the facts of a situation. V. 13
- 5. We must seek *healing* from God for past trauma. V. 14
- 6. We must be ever *learning*. Discernment is a skill that one acquires when they put God's word into action by doing what it says. V. 15
