The Weight of a Heart

Proverbs 21:1-5 ¹The king's heart is a waterway in the hand of the LORD; He directs it where He pleases. ²All a man's ways seem right to him, but the LORD weighs the heart. ³To do righteousness and justice is more desirable to the LORD than sacrifice. ⁴Haughty eyes and a proud heart— the guides of the wicked—are sin. ⁵The plans of the diligent bring plenty, as surely as haste leads to poverty. BSB

- **I.** Here are the details of this passage.
 - **A.** God is sovereign over <u>earthly</u> rulers. V. 1 We still need to vote, but God will do His will no matter who wins.
 - **B.** We can justify what we do in our <u>*flesh*</u> and make it sound godly. God sees our heart. We cannot fool Him. V. 2
 - **C.** Righteous actions and a heart for the disenfranchised is more <u>*important*</u> to God than what we give up for Him. V. 3
 - D. Humility is a <u>protector</u> from sin. We must let our humility guide us in our actions. V. 4
 - E. We must think through things and weigh our <u>decisions</u> in light of God's word. This will benefit everyone around us. V. 5
