The Rarity of Gratitude

Luke 17:11-19 ¹¹While Jesus was on His way to Jerusalem, He was passing between Samaria and Galilee. ¹²As He entered one of the villages, He was met by ten lepers. They stood at a distance ¹³and raised their voices, shouting, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!" ¹⁴When Jesus saw them, He said, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And as they were on their way, they were cleansed. ¹⁵When one of them saw that he was healed, he came back, praising God in a loud voice. ¹⁶He fell facedown at Jesus' feet in thanksgiving to Him—and he was a Samaritan. ¹⁷"Were not all ten cleansed?" Jesus asked. "Where then are the other nine? ¹⁸Was no one found except this foreigner to return and give glory to God?" ¹⁹Then Jesus said to him, "Rise and go; your faith has made you well!" (BSB)

- **I.** Here are the details of this passage.
 - A. Jesus was <u>on His way</u> to Jerusalem and was passing between Samaria and Galilee. V. 11
 - **B.** He was met by ten *lepers* who were of mixed heritage. V. 12, 18.
 - C. They pleaded for *mercy* from the master. V. 13
 - **D.** Jesus sent them to the priests and while they were <u>obeying</u> this command, they were all healed. V. 14
 - E. Only the Samaritan returned to give thanks for the miracle. V. 15-16
 - F. Jesus *praised* the man for his faith. V. 19
- II. What can we learn from this?
 - **A.** Opportunities to minister come to us *randomly*. They were on their way to the temple to worship.
 - **B.** Difficult times tend to bring everyone <u>together</u>. The lepers did not care what each of their ethnicity was.
 - **C.** We must learn <u>humility</u>. We all are in need for mercy. Mercy is not getting something that you deserve. None of us have earned the favor of God.
 - **D.** Obedience is often <u>required</u> of us. We must obey what we already know to be true.
 - **E.** It is important to stop and give thanks for what we <u>already</u> have.
 - F. Obedience, humility and thankfulness show our true *faith*.
- **III.** What can we do with this message.
 - **A.** We must be ready <u>at all times</u> to take full advantage of opportunities that come our way to show Christ to others.
 - **B.** Our thinking in regards to the appearance of others must conform to how **God** sees people.
 - **C.** We must become thankful for what we already have. This thankfulness should be **expressed**.
 - **D.** Paying it *forward* shows our true faith.
